His design work takes him all over Mexico and frequently internationally to other Latin American countries and the US.

Jimmy trained on all the major lighting console brands including grandMA, Avolites and WholeHog, so he can be quick and confident when programming shows on any of these platforms. He has been using Robe products regularly in his work for the last 10 years, starting with the 575 series. He now works a lot with the LEDWash series and MMX fixtures, both via Prolight, and on shows he is lighting where the equipment is being sourced locally for a band or an event via other companies around the country ...
