In 2016, he embraced the industrial aspects of lighting, joining the Lyon-based manufacturer LEC, where, in a newly created post, he explored the intersection between the commercial networking and engineering teams, leveraging his diverse skill base at the crossroads between conceptual objectives and technical constraints.
